## 1994: Lesbian Avengers Leaflet

The Lesbian Archive host a collection of Lesbian Avenger material - the infamous direct action group that organised publicity stunts to draw attention to lesbophobia and weren't hesitant in taking on international campaigns.

**Together** we can demand that the heads of state of Latin America & the Caribbean respect lesbian rights *or face the consequences* in the U.S. and at home.

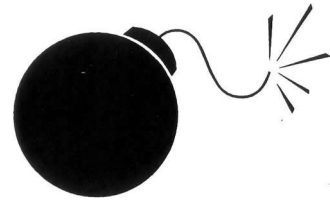
**Together** we can demand that the Fourth World Conference on Women *prioritize lesbian rights* for the next decade. *Ain't I a woman?*
